The historic Cape Playhouse in Dennis, MA — the theatre where Broadway goes to summer- is accepting resumes for a Shop Swing for our 2024 Summer Season which includes productions of 'Tick, Tick,...Boom!', 'Million Dollar Quartet', 'Beautiful: A Carole King Musical', 'Waitress', and 'The 39 Steps'. The salary for this position is \$675 paid weekly. Salary is based on a 40 hour scheduled work week, any hours worked after 40 will be compensated.

The Shop Swing is responsible for aiding in all elements of scenic engineering, construction, paint treatments of all scenic elements and helping during load-ins and strikes typical of a traditional summer theater. They may be supervised by the Lead Carpenter, Props Supervisor, or Scenic Charge according to the needs of the shop.

The Cape Playhouse values tradition, hard work, kindness, generosity, passion, and professionalism. Must have excellent communication skills, high energy, the ability to lead crews, and be organized. Ability to read drafts and follow plans is required. A degree in scenic construction/Scenic Art or equivalent and at least one year of experience in a professional shop is recommended. Experience in welding (MIG) is preferred. Shop Swing must be able to lift and carry up to 50 pounds and perform physical activities such as, but not limited to, lifting, bending, standing, climbing.

The Shop Swing reports to the Technical Director. Position begins on the Cape on May 13th and ends on September 1st. There is some flexibility for start and end dates.
