

### Sound Supervisor

The historic Cape Playhouse in Dennis, MA — the theatre where Broadway goes to summer- is accepting resumes for a Lighting Supervisor for our 2024 Summer Season which includes productions of 'Tick, Tick,...Boom!', 'Million Dollar Quartet', 'Beautiful: A Carole King Musical', 'Waitress', and 'The 39 Steps'. The salary for this position is \$1000 paid weekly. Salary is based on a 50 hour scheduled work week, any hours worked after 50 will be compensated.

The Sound Supervisor is responsible for maintaining the season sound rental package and working with sound designers to determine the additional rental needs of each production. They will maintain the sound department area, keeping it clean and making sure that it is a safe working environment. They will supervise an apprentice and all relevant production assistants during load-ins, strikes, work calls, tech rehearsals, previews and performances for all productions. They will lead the setup, testing and cabling of equipment prior to tech and performances. They will also assist the development staff with any sound needs for Playhouse events.

The Cape Playhouse values collaboration, hard-work, compassion, and creativity. Applicant must have excellent communication skills and be a team player. Experience with vectorworks is recommended. Advanced skill in mixing is required.

The Sound Supervisor reports to the Production Manager. Position begins on the Cape on May 20th and continues until September 15th. There is flexibility for start and end dates.
